

CAMP AREA:

- 30 acres of woods with hiking and nature trails
- 100 yards of open field
- Frontage on Coldwater Lake
- Coldwater Lake County Park nearby

The 40 acre area is ideal for all recreational activities, including archery, hiking, band practice, and organized sports. There is space to lay out football, baseball, softball, soccer fields, and other sports areas. There is a cement basketball court on the field and one on the camp grounds. Cross country ski trail sites can be developed as needed.

The camp grounds include a fire pit with picnic tables, benches and plenty of four square pads. There is a beach area for supervised swimming with a dock on Coldwater Lake.

CAMP BUILDINGS:

The campground has a main lodge and two dormitories with 100 feet frontage and beach on Coldwater Lake.

LODGE:

The main lodge is the center of day time and evening activities. It has complete professional kitchen facilities and dinnerware for 100 persons. A large chest freezer and commercial refrigerator, professional mixer, and microwave is in the kitchen.

The dining area is furnished with family style tables and benches. This makes the room ideal for organizational meetings.

The large recreation room is a place for rainy day activities and dancing or just a place to lounge in front of a large open fireplace.

The lodge is equipped with handicapped restrooms and is heated only by the large fireplace in the recreation room.

Dorms:

One dorm will sleep 50 people and the second dorm will sleep 60, all on bunk beds. Each dorm is divided into two sides with hot water shower and toilet facilities in each side.

LAKE FRONTAGE:

A sandy beach area provides excellent swimming opportunities for campers. Try your luck at fishing or just relax and lay on the beach. Coldwater Lake offers excellent catches of pan fish and other larger species.

Boats can be launched at the Isabella County Park and docked at the camp.

Camp history:

The camp was built in 1952 to provide an area where 4-H clubs could enjoy the many fine advantages of camping. The camp is a non-profit organization devoted to the young people in the surrounding community. The camp is owned by Isabella County 4-H and run by the Isabella 4-H Camp Association. New funding has allowed us to make many needed improvements to the infrastructure of the camp.

The camp is open to outside groups for recreational and instructional activities. We offer low rates and any money remaining at the end of the year is put back into improvements of the facility.

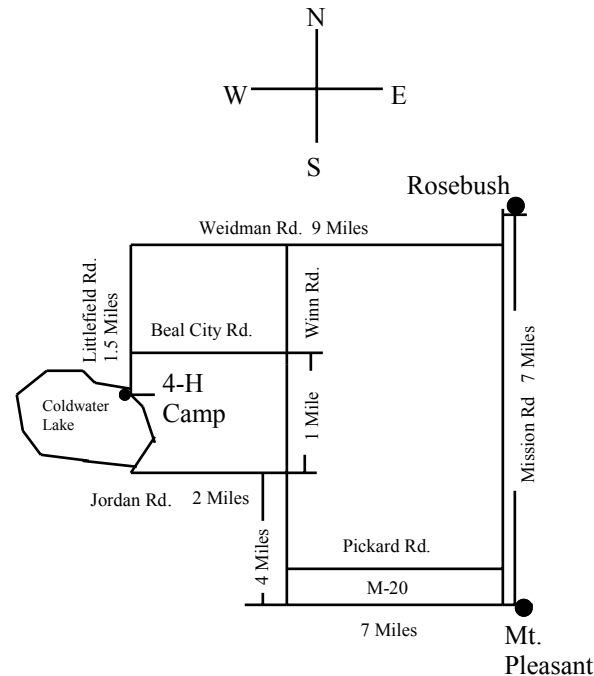

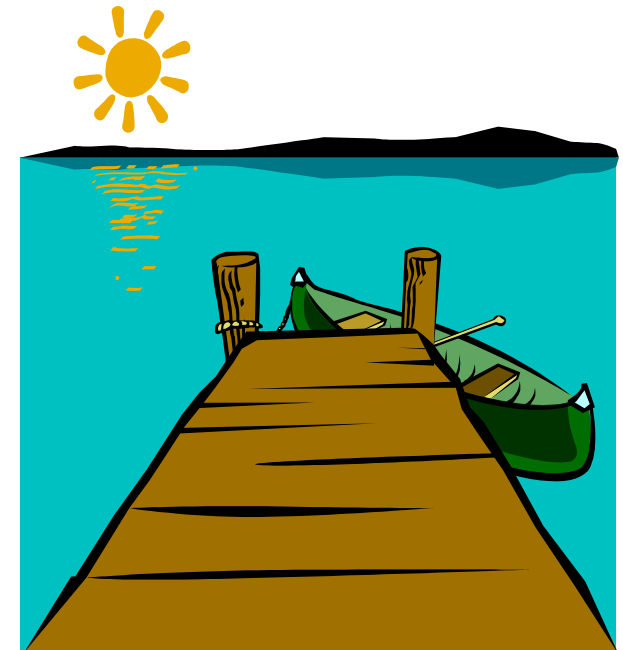
