

## Trail Etiquette & Park Rules

Throughout the year, the trails are used by hikers, runners, mountain bikers, fishing enthusiasts, cross-country skiers, student groups and many others. Responsible trail users recognize the need to exercise care and tolerance for others. Please remember the following points while using the trail system.

- During the winter months, pets are allowed north of the Chippewa River unless otherwise noted.
- Hikers are not to walk on the groomed ski trails and no dogs are permitted on trails south of the river when the ground is snow covered.
- "Skate-Skiing" is allowed on the 1/2 mile "Raceway Path" which is set aside for this purpose. All other trails are closed to "Skate Skiing".
- Respect private property.
- Fireworks are prohibited.
- Campfires are allowed only in designated containers.
- No hunting.
- No littering. *Leave nothing, take only memories.*
- Motorized vehicles are prohibited except on designated roadways and parking lots.
- Non-motorized bicycles are allowed on the trail system, pedestrians have the right of way.

- 11 - Oak Ridge Interpretive Path (0.49 mi.)

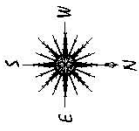

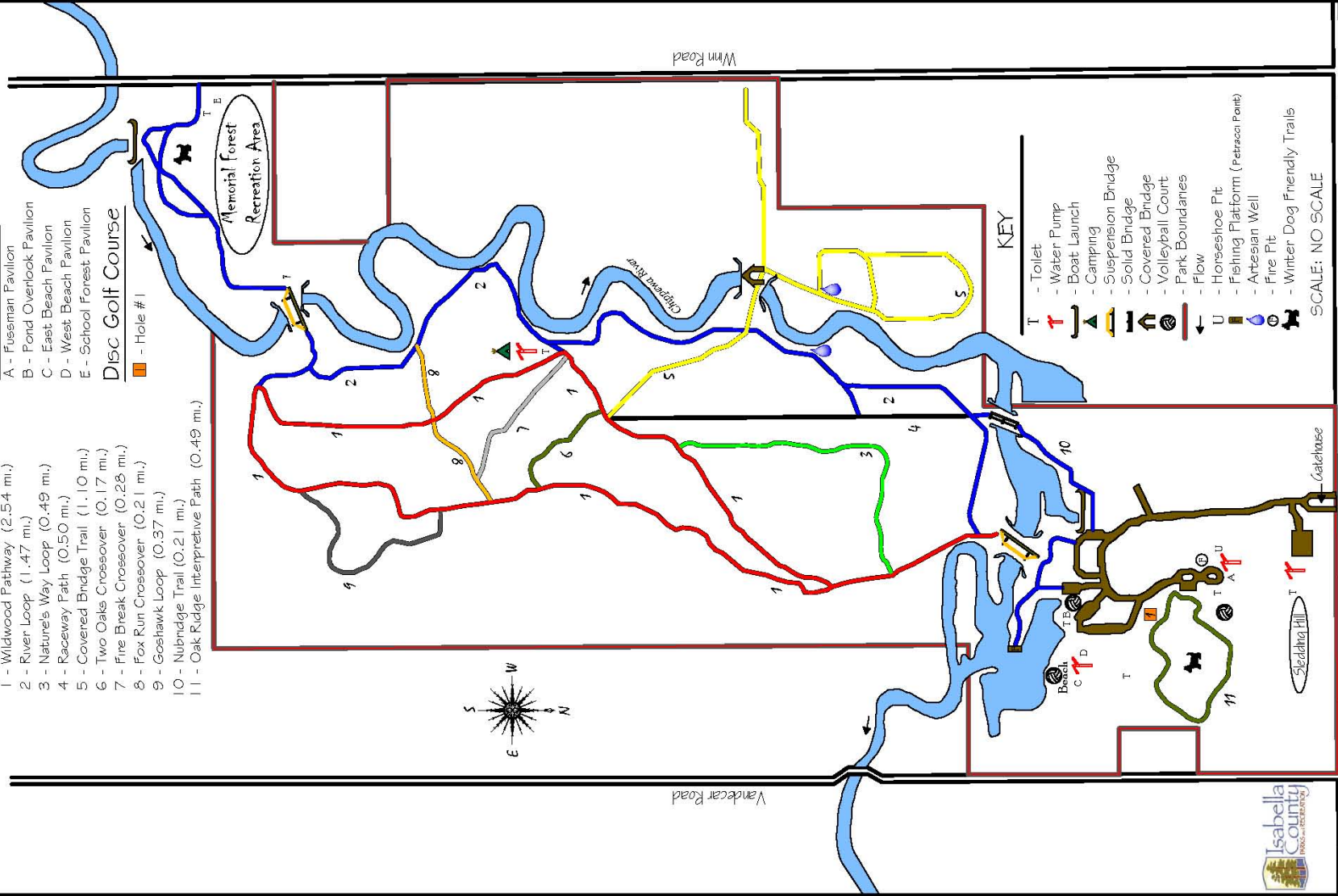
