A Hazardous product will have any one of the following characteristics:



■ TOXIC:  
Poisonous or capable of causing acute illness



■ FLAMMABLE:  
Burns easily



■ CORROSIVE:  
Eats other materials



■ REACTIVE:  
Explode if exposed to water, heat, or shock

When transporting Household Hazardous wastes please observe these guidelines;

1. Do not transport containers with open tops.
2. Keep product in original, sealed and labeled containers.
3. Ensure that containers are not leaking prior to transporting.
4. Do not mix the contents of unknown or unlabeled containers.
5. Secure all containers in vehicle to ensure that they cannot slide, tip or spill.
6. Do over pack all leaking or questionable containers in a clear plastic bag or leak proof container.
