SUP#17-01 Verizon Wireless Site - "Tower Lake" - Gilmore Township

Mr. Johnson stated that an application was received by our office from Andrew Webber on behalf of Verizon Wireless which included a site plan. The property the tower is located upon does contain a residence and the proposed location for the tower is within 500 feet of the existing residential use. In February of 2017, Verizon Wireless did receive a variance (#17-01) for the reduction of this distance. After review of the criteria in Section 12.05 (H) of the ordinance the application appears to be complete and meet the criteria of the ordinance.

Robert LaBell spoke on behalf of Verizon Wireless. He explained the location of Tower Lake Tower in regards to the coverage and how it will work with the Littlefield Lake cell tower to help reduce the load of calls which will come from that area.
