On Monday, March 23, 2020, Governor Whitmer issued Executive Order 2020-21, Temporary requirement to suspend activities that are not necessary to sustain or protect life. **In response to the Order, Isabella County Government facilities and the Isabella County Trial Court will be closed through Monday, April 13, 2020.**

Limited essential services will be available on an as needed basis. The public is encouraged to access County services via email, www.isabellacounty.org, or phone. A complete listing of County Office phone numbers is available on the website. Please call before coming to a County facility.

The Sheriff's Office will continue to be fully staffed, however, if you have business at the Jail, please follow the directions posted on the entry door, or call 989-772-5911. Central Dispatch / 9-1-1 and Emergency Management will also continue to be fully staffed.
