Due to an increasing number of positive COVID-19 cases, numerous employees under quarantine, the Isabella County Building will be closing at 4:30 p.m. on Friday, November 13, 2020 and will reopen at 8:00 a.m. Monday, November 30, 2020. This closure affects only the County Building located at 200 N. Main Street, Mount Pleasant, Michigan 48858.

Isabella County is promoting remote work to the maximum extent possible. The public is encouraged to access County services via email, the County's website at www.isabellacounty.org or by phone. A complete listing of County office phone numbers is available on the website. Please call before coming to the facility.

The Isabella County Trial Court implemented a phased in approach to reopening the Courthouse. This plan follows the Michigan Supreme Court Administrative Order 2020-14 which established the process for all state trial courts. Due to the increase in Isabella County confirmed COVID-19 cases, the Trial Court is required to remain in its Phase Two.
