

# Basic Disc Golf Terminology

**Tee Pad** - The location or designated area from which the first throw of the golf hole is supposed to take place. Tee Pads are typically made of concrete or rubber.

**The Basket** - Once a disc comes to rest in the basket, or suspended by the chains, the hole is considered complete.

**Throw** - The act of advancing the disc towards the basket. This can be accomplished by many different throwing styles; Backhand, Forehand, Rollers. Each throw is counted towards the player's score.

**Lie** - The spot where the disc comes to rest, often marked by a mini-disc marker.

**Par** - Like in regular golf, each disc golf hole has a posted par. The par is the desired number of strokes, or throws, that a player would need to complete the hole.

**Drive** - Any throw off the tee pad or a throw from the fairway designed for maximum distance.

**Approach** - Usually the second shot of a hole, designed to place the disc within putting distance.

**Putt** - The final throw(s) of the hole aimed at getting your disc to come to rest in the basket or suspended by the chains; any throw within the circle (10 meter radius).



## Deerfield Disc Golf Course

Made possible by Jordan Bruursema, along with volunteers from the Mount Pleasant Disc Golf Club, over 200 volunteer hours went into getting the course up and running by July 4, 2009! The 18 hole course was funded through donations from local businesses, individuals and Isabella County Parks. Many volunteers along with County Park employees worked together to build this premier disc golf course in Michigan.

## Wildwood Disc Golf Course

Designed by John "Nacho" Norkowski, Craig Clingan, and Members of the Mount Pleasant Disc Golf Club, Wildwood offers 18 holes that intertwine with the original Deerfield Course. Wildwood offers elevation changes, elevated tees and a water crossing. Discraft Chainstar baskets were installed June 30, 2013.
