GENERAL SUMMARY

Performs routine maintenance and developmental tasks within a particular park site. Duties may result in exposure to inclement weather. This position works under the direct supervision of the Park Manager or other Park Supervisory Staff.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

The intent of this job description is to provide a representative summary of the major duties and responsibilities performed by incumbents of this job. Employees may be requested to perform job-related tasks other than those specifically presented in this description.

- Patrols park to prevent fires, vandalism, and theft. Monitors behavior of park visitors, cautions visitors against infractions of the Ordinance and notifies supervisor of unresolved problems.
- Monitors motor vehicles entering and leaving the campground. Limits entry to properly registered campers.
- Monitors radio communications system with other park staff and Central Dispatch.
- Greets visitors and provides information pertaining to park use, safety requirements and area points of interest.
- Directs vehicle traffic and reports accidents.
- Performs basic electrical, plumbing and mechanical repairs.
- Performs janitorial operations on cabins, comfort stations, bathhouses, picnic pavilions, and other structures, satisfying standards of cleanliness and sanitation.
- Picks up ground litter. Empties trash containers.
- Performs preventive maintenance on vehicles and other motorized equipment.
- Performs minor repairs to fences, signs, picnic tables and other facilities and equipment.
- Assists persons with injuries to obtain appropriate medical care.
- Performs other duties as assigned.

MINIMUM ENTRANCE QUALIFICATIONS

Education and Experience

- High school diploma or equivalent.
- Less than one (1) year experience.
- Any equivalent combination of training, education, and experience that provides the required skills, knowledge and abilities.

Licenses or Certifications

- Valid driver's license.

OTHER JOB REQUIREMENTS

- None.

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS

- Some security and park operations experience.
