It was moved by Commissioner Weber and seconded by Commissioner Swaney to approve the State Tax Commission Form L-4029 – 2026 Tax Rate Request form setting the 2026 Isabella County Separate Tax Limitation Operating Rate at 6.61 Mills, and authorize the Board Chairperson and County Clerk to sign the same.
