- I. **Call To Order:** by Committee Chair - Jerry Jaloszynski in conference room B of the Central Michigan District Health Department, 2012 E Preston St, Mt Pleasant, MI 48858. In Person Meeting.

- III. **Approval of Agenda:** Anna Reetz motioned to approve the May special meeting agenda, as presented, Amy Campbell seconded, motion carried.
- IV. **Public Comments (Agenda Items Only):**
 - a. Representatives from New Hope Behavioral Health Center, Cari Maniteau and Melissa Porter asked that For-Profit organizations be considered for Opioid Settlement dollars. Asking for change in request for proposal language and bylaw language to include For-Profit eligibility.
 - b. Representative from Behavioral Health Group (BHG), Jennifer Obrian Isenhath, asked that For-Profit organizations be eligible to submit proposals for opioid settlement dollars.
- V. **Consideration: Shall For-Profit Opioid Remediation Service Providers Be Eligible to Submit Settlement Funding for Proposals**
 - a. Amy Dolinky from Michigan Association of Counties spoke on the phone about concerns when considering For Profit entities applying for opioid settlement dollars.
 - i. Melissa Porter with New Hope Behavioral Health Center was allowed the opportunity to address some of those concerns.

- ii. Jennifer Obrian Isenhath with BHG was allowed the opportunity to share her experience with transparent reporting with granted dollars.
 - iii. Ryan Griffus expressed support of allowing For-Profit eligibility with clear guidelines on how granted dollars can be used by For-Profits. Anna Reetz and Sue Hahn echoed that support noting this only allows the opportunity for For-Profits to apply but does not guarantee their request will be funded.
- b. Amy Campbell motioned to approve the eligibility of For-Profit entities applying for opioid settlement dollars, Jennifer McNally seconded, motion carried.
