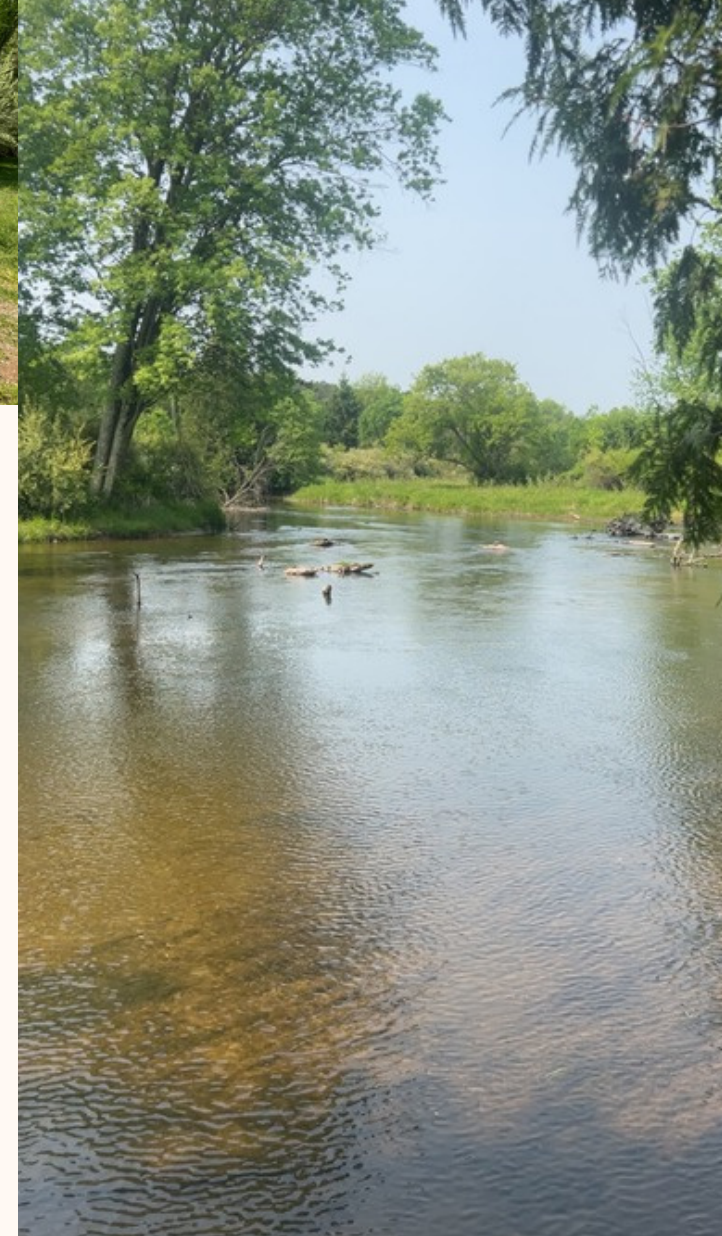




ABOUT MERIDIAN

Leave No Trace:**

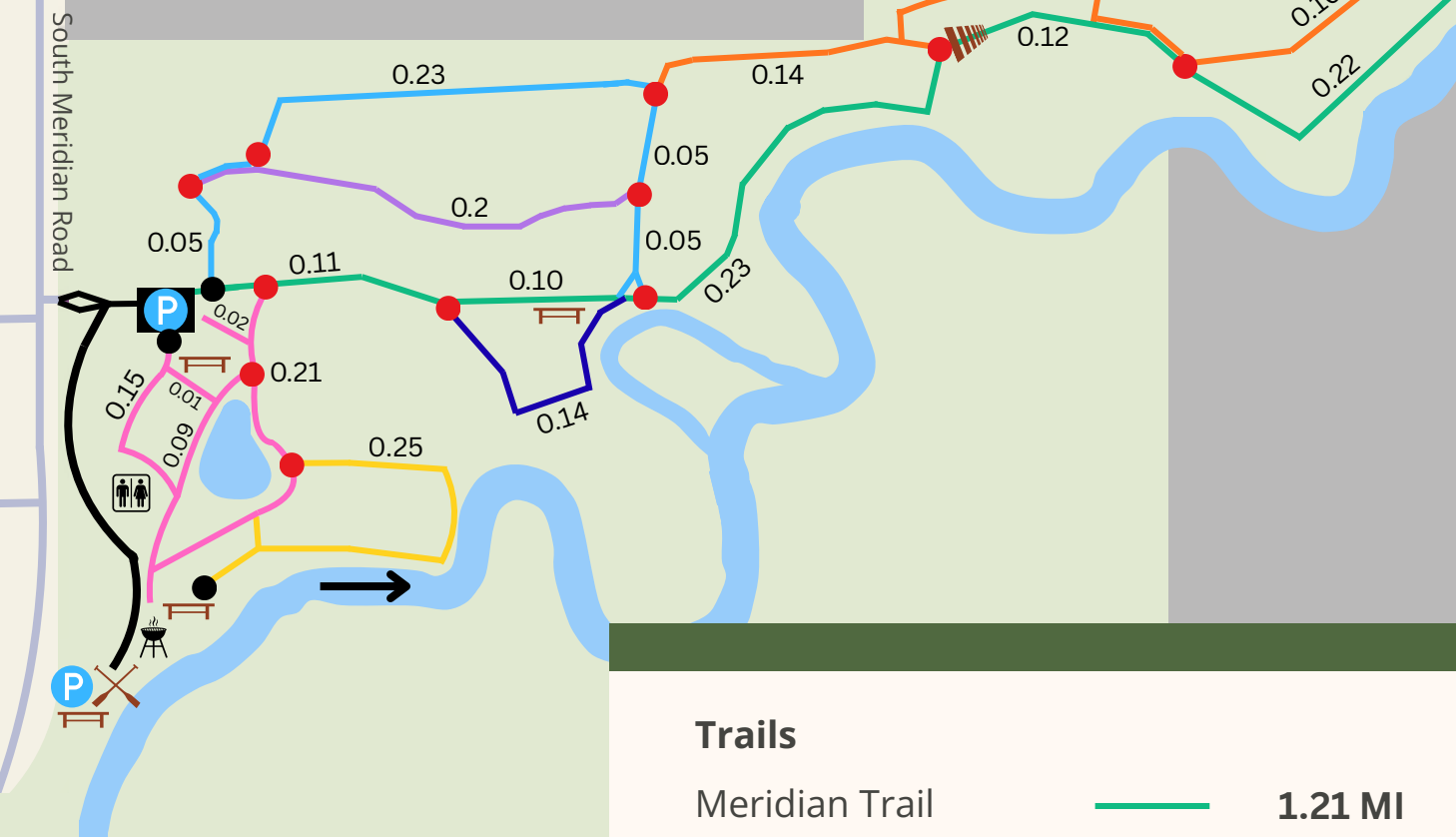
- Pedestrians have the right of way.

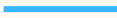
