1. It was moved by Commissioner Jaloszynski and seconded by Commissioner Moreno to approve and place on file the June 16, 2026 Regular Meeting Minutes. Motion carried.

Finance Committee/Committee of the Whole:

1. It was moved by Commissioner Swaney and seconded by Commissioner Jaloszynski to ratify and place on file the June 12th, 2026 Invoice List in the amount of \$573,722.90; the June 19, 2026 Invoice List in the amount of \$175,349.64; the June 26, 2026 Invoice List in the amount of \$439,064.70; the July 3, 2026 Invoice List in the amount of \$335,146.35; the July 10, 2026 Invoice List in the amount of \$1,018,475.98; the Adjustments List dated June 11, 2026; and the Adjustments List dated July 2, 2026. 2. It was moved by Commissioner Weber and seconded by Commissioner Swaney to approve the proposed Building Inspections Fee Adjustments including new fees effective August 1, 2026 pursuant to PA 230 of 1972 and the Isabella County State Construction Code Ordinance, Ordinance #06-01, as listed and presented. Motion carried with Yeas: Commissioners Moreno, Engler, Jaloszynski, and Swaney. Nays: Weber, Campbell.
3. It was moved by Commissioner Campbell and seconded by Commissioner Jaloszynski to approve the purchase of three (3) Administrative/Investigative vehicles for the Isabella County Sheriff's Office, at a cost of \$91,202.00 using Awarded Public Safety Revenue Sharing funds, in addition to Budget Amendment #2026-26BOC, and authorize the Board Chairperson to sign the same. Sheriff Michael Main was present to explain. Motion carried with Yeas: Commissioners Weber, Moreno, Campbell, Engler, Jaloszynski, and Swaney. Nays: None
4. It was moved by Commissioner Moreno and seconded by Commissioner Jaloszynski to approve the FY25 Homeland Security Grant Program Intergovernmental Agreement between the West Michigan Regional and Medical Consortium and Isabella County Emergency Management, and authorize the Board Chairperson to

sign the same. Motion carried with Yeas: Commissioners Weber, Moreno, Campbell, Engler, Jaloszynski, and Swaney. Nays: None

5. It was moved by Commissioner Jaloszynski and supported by Commissioner Swaney to approve the Isabella County Day Treatment Contract Extension through September 30, 2028, between Isabella County, Isabella County Trial Court, and McBride Quality Care, and authorize the Board Chairperson to sign the same. It was moved by Commissioner Swaney and seconded by Commissioner Jaloszynski to approve the immediate order of the Isabella County Parks – State Initiative Playground Design from GameTime Recreation via MiDeal Vendor Sinclair Recreation, to receive \$20,024.99 in grant funding to be put toward the equipment by completing the installation prior to December 31, 2026. It was moved by Commissioner Weber and seconded by Commissioner Swaney to approve the On-Call Stipend for Prosecuting Attorneys at a pay rate of \$550 per week and \$200 per federal holiday for FY 2027 with the understanding that this stipend cannot be received by the elected prosecutor, and that this request must be made on an annual basis. It was moved by Commissioner Campbell and seconded by Commissioner Moreno to approve the Fiscal Year 2027 Victim Rights Prosecutor Grant Application, and authorize the Board Chairperson to sign the same, and further authorize the Prosecuting Attorney to sign in Egrams. Motion carried with Yeas: Commissioners Weber, Moreno, Campbell, Engler, Jaloszynski, and Swaney. Nays: None
