



STEVENSON LAKE – LAKE LEVEL **SPECIAL ASSESSMENT UPDATE**

July 30 Public Hearing

- The Isabella County Drain Commissioner held a public hearing on July 30, 2026, to review a proposed special assessment roll and computation of costs for the Stevenson Lake – Lake Level under Part 307 of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act
- During and after the public hearing, the Drain Commissioner received feedback and additional information from property owners regarding the proposed assessments
- The Drain Commissioner researched all feedback and information received and made changes to the special assessment roll as appropriate

Final Approval of Assessments

- Part 307 requires final approval of the special assessment roll and computation of costs by resolution of the Isabella County Board of Commissioners
- The Board of Commissioners was originally scheduled to review the proposed assessments on August 18, 2026
- To provide property owners with additional time to review the proposed assessments and submit feedback, the Board of Commissioners will postpone **consideration of a resolution related to the assessments until the Board's regular meeting on September 1, 2026 at 5:00PM**
